To All Hahn Employees:



TIPS FOR SUMMER

from.....Judy Sikes, Plant Nurse

Just a reminder to all of you who get Poison Ivy, Poison Oak, or Poison Sumac. After contact, remove clothing and wash skin with soap and water. Most of the time this is all you need to do to remove the poison and stop the itching.

Snake Bites...Be aware of your surroundings. The two known snakes in Indiana are the Copperhead and the Timber Rattlesnake. Kentucky has both of these plus the Cottonmouth. If bitten, don't panic. Stay calm, and never run. Apply a loose, constricting band "above" the bite; a scarf, pantyhose, or a tie will do. Lower the involved area and apply ice if available. Then transport the person to the nearest hospital.

VACATION




The Plant will be shut down for vacation the last two weeks of July, July 17 through July 31st.






HEA GOLF TOURNAMENT






Stan and Del demonstrated their golfing ability in the Hahn Tournament recently. Stan won, but Del reportedly had the best looking shoes!


