

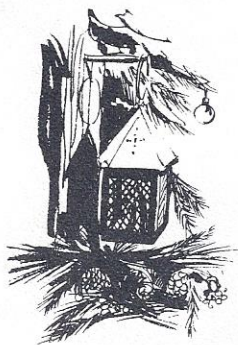

While all of us have our problems, we have many things to be thankful for and it is good that we take the time for giving thanks, sharing gifts and getting together with family and friends for fun and fellowship.

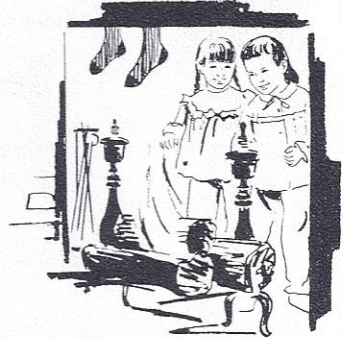
Thanks to everyone for their efforts and cooperation this past year and let's work together to make next year the best one ever!

NEW EMPLOYEES



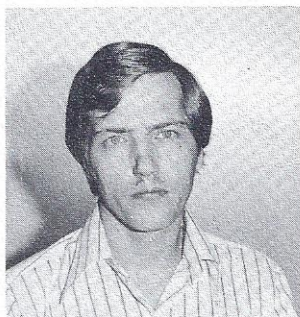
"Welcome" to all new employees in the plant. Since October, we have added about 130 new people in production.

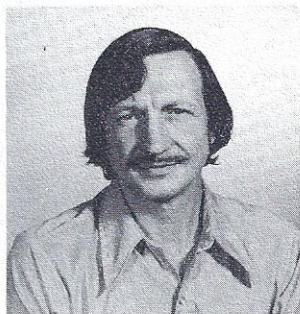
